**REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Admissions for Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs)/Non Resident Indians (NRIs)/ Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) to B.Tech. Courses in NSUT through DASA 2019-20.**

All provisionally selected applicants who have been issued Provisional Admission Letter by DASA (Coordinated by (NIT, Surathkal, Karnataka) for admission to B.Tech. program in NSUT have to report at the University for admission on **July 24, 2019 at 10:30 A.M.** All admissions would be subject to the verification of original certificates/ documents and satisfactory physical fitness as prescribed by the NSUT during the time of admission.

If provisionally selected candidate does not report for admission at NSUT on above specified date with required original documents / testimonials / certificates, he/she shall forfeit his/her right of admission and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained. It is in the interest of the candidates that they should regularly visit institute's website [www.nsut.ac.in](http://www.nsut.ac.in) for any specific updates.

**1. PLACE OF REPORTING**

**2. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF REPORTING**

Original transcripts/certificates and their **self-attested copies** of following documents are required to be produced/submitted at the time of reporting:

1. Provisional Admission Letter issued by the DASA, NIT, Surathkal.
2. Details and proof of fee payment made to DASA, NIT, Surathkal. In case of payment by SWIFT transfer, the complete details should be attached with the printed application form.
3. Printed copy of online application form submitted at the time of online registration, duly signed by the candidate and parent/guardian.
4. Valid Passport of Candidate (Nationals of Nepal who do not have a passport, Authenticated Citizenship Card has to be produced).
5. Proof for date of birth (Secondary Education Board/University Certificate [Class X or equivalent] or any certificate issued by the Government authorities).
6. SAT Subject Test Score Card.
7. Mark Sheet of 10th, 11th and 12th (or) Equivalent examination(s).
8. Certificate from School authorities (in the format given in Appendix-II (DASA brochure 2019) on letter head of the school) as proof of completion of 11th and 12th Standard or equivalent.
9. Proof of last 2 years of education in foreign country in case of NRI (School leaving certificate/Mark sheets/Study Certificate as in appendix IV of DASA brochure 2019).
10. Three recent passport size photographs, preferably same as the photo uploaded in the application portal.
11. Medical Fitness as per format enclosed.
12. Copy of passport of the parents working in the Gulf in case of CIWG Candidates.
13. Copy of parents Visa in case of CIWG Candidates.
14. Copy of Parents work permit (if any) in case of CIWG Candidates.

After verification of above mentioned documents, Provisional Admission Letter will be issued by NSUT.

**Note:**

- i. Provisionally selected candidates should bring originals of all required documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies for verification.
- ii. If any supporting document is in languages other than English or Hindi, authenticated translated copy of the same in English or Hindi must also be provided.
- iii. Incomplete/illegible application and documentary evidences in any respect would be summarily rejected without any communication to the candidate.
